Legal grounds for work (simplified scheme)


- Work permits (3 types)

Ukrainians in Poland in 2022

- Beginning of the year: 1.3-1.5 mln.
- Mid-year: 3.0-3.5 mln.
- End of the year: 2.0-2.4 mln.*








Migrants War refugees

Labour market characteristics of Ukrainian war refugees in Poland (Survey data; February 2023)




Labour market status
